

OUR CASUALTIES ABROAD NOW TOTAL 35,132

61 Killed, 127 Severely Wounded, and 81 Missing in New Army Lists

WASHINGTON, Sept. 19.—The War Department today gave out two army casualty lists, which contained 317 names, bringing the total for the army up to 32,000. One Marine Corps casualty list was issued, which contained 9 names, bringing the total for that arm to 3,108. The total for army and marines is now 35,132.

Army lists today contained the names of 61 killed in action, 21 died of wounds, 9 died of accident, 12 died of disease, 127 severely wounded, 3 wounded to a degree undetermined, 3 slightly wounded, and 81 missing.
